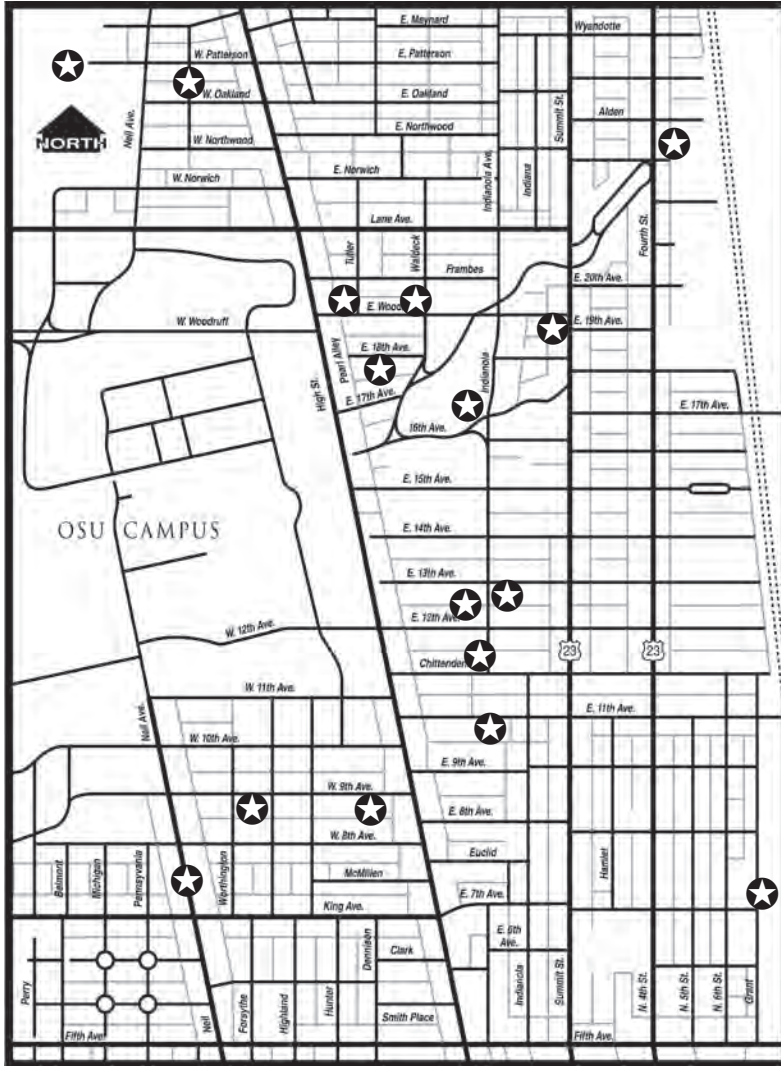


Before moving out, do your part for the community!

KEEP IT CLEAN - Drop off furniture, mattresses, and other bulk trash items at any of 16 collection sites.

The City of Columbus Refuse Collection Division will conduct a special collection of bulk trash in the University District from **Monday, August 23, through Monday, September 13**, only at drop-off locations. Bulk trash includes furniture, mattresses, appliances and carpets.



★ BULK COLLECTION SITES

- Rear of 1975-1981 Summit Street
- West Patterson Avenue next to Tuttle Pool
- Rear of 108-116 East Woodruff Avenue
- East Woodruff Avenue at Tuller Street
- Rear of 2150 North Fourth Street
- Rear of 65 East 18th Avenue
- 140 East 16th Avenue (Parking Lot)
- Rear of 155 East 13th Avenue (only after 8/31)
- Rear of 104 East 12th Avenue
- Rear of 100 Chittenden Avenue
- Rear of 107-109 East 11th Avenue
- Rear of 51 West 9th Avenue
- Rear of 175 West 9th Avenue
- NE corner of Grant Avenue & East 7th Avenue
- Williams Street between Oakland & Patterson
- Rear of 1474 Neil Avenue

* Do not place bulk trash in your regular refuse container or leave bulk trash in your alley.
